AFFIDAVIT AS TO STATUS OF LICENSURE – N.C.G.S. 87-1

I have entered a construction project where the cost of the undertaking exceeds \$40,000; I have read G.S. Section 87-1. I certify that I am not allowing an unlicensed general contractor to perform the duties of a general contractor, which, I understand from reading G.S. Section 87-1 that “Any person, firm, or corporation who constructs or alters a building on land owned by that person, firm, or corporation provided (i) the building is intended **solely for occupancy** by that person and his/her/their family, firm, or corporation for at least **12 months** following completion, it shall be presumed that the person, firm or corporation did not intend the building solely for occupancy by that person and his/her/their family, firm, or corporation.
